• 3 WAY LEARNING CONVERSATIONS:

Wednesday, 6 July from 1:00pm - 8.00pm and Thursday, 7 July from 3.30pm - 6.00pm, BMIS will be hosting our Report Evening. This is a discussion with parents/caregivers, students and teachers as to how your child is progressing with their learning thus far in 2022.


The small carpark at the front of the school is for visitors only. Please do not park in the driveway (blocking others) or on the grass.


EBULLY EMAIL ADDRESS:
