SEESAW:

It is reassuring to know that as parents/ caregivers, you can check in your child's learning and mahi through their BMIS SeeSaw platform.

SeeSaw is the equivalent to a 'portfolio' of work showing the progression of learning. SeeSaw increases student and family engagement with your child's learning as well as giving you real-time insights into your child's learning. It houses your child's exemplars, extracts from their workbooks, recordings, pictures of their development and so much more.

Please make time to check out your child's BMIS SeeSaw platform with their Goal Setting and Personal Best Learning Profile – these are standardized school documents that reflect and project where your child is at and their next steps. Commenting on your child's SeeSaw mahi is encouraged. Your child and your child's teacher look forward to seeing your comments.

PROFESSIONAL LEARNING:

Currently, teachers are continuing with

their professional learning — Culturally Responsive Pedagogical Change. As part of our evidence-based data gathering, the school has gathered student voice and would like as much community voice as possible. IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

YEAR 7 & YEAR 8 SCHOOL-BASED IMMUNISATION PROGRAMME 2022:

- It is important to keep up with schedule vaccines despite the challenges COVID-19 presents.
- The Public Health Nurse team are scheduled to visit Bruce McLaren 31 May 2022.
- Year 7 students will be offered Boostrix vaccine (Tdap) in school. This vaccine is a booster of tetanus, diphtheria, and whooping cough (pertussis). Most children received these immunisations as preschoolers.
- Year 8 students will be offered human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine in school. This is a New Zealand schedule vaccine that is recommended to be given at 12 years of age. Students need two doses with a 6-month gap between dose 1 and 2.
- Information on the vaccine and a consent form have been sent home. Please complete the form (fill either section A for yes or section B for no) and return to the school. We will not vaccinate your child without a signed consent form.

As you know Bruce McLaren Intermediate takes 'bullying' very seriously. We have an e-bullying email address. Students and parents are able to access this by simply emailing from any email server. The email goes directly to Mrs Wood. She will action any ebully emails as soon as she receives them. Contact will also be made with the sender of the email. Often issues are discussed within the family home and out of school hours so this gives parents and students alike, an opportunity to deal with issues immediately.

OFF AT THE GATE:

Discussion with your child about OFF AT THE GATE is imperative. Students, when entering school, are to turn devices off as they enter the school gates and can turn

them on again as they leave the school gates at the end of the day. Students, when entering school, are to get off bicycles, scooters, skateboards and skates at the school gate for everyone's safety. No helmet - no ride. Please support the school in safeguarding everyone.

In CPF RED our students are staggered when leaving school to reduce congestion at the gate.
