EARLY SCHOOL CLOSE:

PAID UNION MEETING FOR NZEI TEACHERS:

On Tuesday, 29 June, Bruce McLaren Intermediate School will be closed at 1:00pm. NZEI teachers will be attending a Paid Union Meeting (PUM) at Glen Eden. Due to almost all of our teachers being NZEI Union Members, the Board of Trustees has directed BMIS to close at 1pm.

Only students catching a Ritchies School Bus will be able to remain on site until their pick up at 3pm. Parents of bus students MUST notify the office if bus students are to stay at school. Bus students will be supervised in the Library.

REMINDER: REPORT EVENING:

Tuesday, 6 July from 3.30pm - 8.00pm and Thursday, 8 July from 1.30pm - 6.00pm, BMIS will be hosting our Report Evening. This is a discussion with parents/ caregivers, students and teachers as to how your child is progressing with their learning thus far in 2021.

BOOKING INTERVIEWS: Booking your interviews is easy! Just jump onto the SkoolLoop App and into the 'Interviews' option. From here you can enter your child's teacher and select your interview time.

EARLY CLOSE: To accommodate these 15 minute slots, **school will close at 1:00pm on Thursday, 8 July.** Tuesday, 6 July will be normal 3.00pm closing time.

BUSES: There will be NO school buses running on Thursday at 1.00pm. Only 'bus students' may be supervised in the Library until 3:00pm - please just let the office know if you need this to happen. Please have a safety plan for your child after 1:00pm on Thursday, 8 July.

SAFE SPACE FOR AFTER SCHOOL:

Students who need to be picked up after school at 3pm are asked to stay in the hall for their safety. With Winter snapping at our heels, the hall is warm and dry. Students are discouraged from waiting at the shops opposite the school due to the heavy traffic congestion, lack of car parks, converging roads onto Bruce McLaren Road with a heavy traffic flow and lack of shelter. Should you wish to pick your child up after school, Silverstone Place, Heremai Street, Corban Ave are safer spots to do so.

BUS TIMES & PARKING:

BMIS is currently are working with Ritchies to pick up bus students to as close to 3:00pm as possible. **PLEASE DO NOT PARK IN THE BUS BAY.** Bus scheduling is a work in progress.

SCHOOL ENTRY:

So that our students are kept as dry as possible, they will be entering school through the Hall Foyer doors off Bruce McLaren Road or the pathway from Silverstone Place and not through the silver gates for the rest of Term 2 and for Term 3 as of Monday, 21 June. Students will exit at 3:00pm through the silver gates and pedestrian gate by the Pedestrian Crossing or using the pathway onto Silverstone Place. We hope that this is helpful and more efficient for our students. Late students will still need to enter school through the office.
