Welcome to 2018. This year promises to be a brilliant year with so much taking place.

It has been fantastic for our Year 7 students to have ruled the school for a day and to have our Year 8s on site so we can commence our school year as a full compliment.

Our whakatau will be held on Wednesday, 7 February at 9:30am for our formal welcome to our Year 7 students. We apologise for the change of date from Tuesday, 30 January, but illness is something we cannot control.

Due to our unpredictable Auckland weather, please ensure your child has their school sun hat and a light rain jacket at hand. Sunblock is provided in each classroom, water fountains are placed around the school and we encourage students to regularly hydrate, eat and find shade. We follow Sun Safe practices and ask you to discuss this with your child also.

BMIS has received its 'draft copy' of the ERO review completed Wk8, Term 4, 2017 and I am excited to share the final version with you soon. Much progress has been made in the last 2 years – that is for sure!

Due to the nature of a small school, we rely heavily on assistance from parents to make sport possible at BMIS. We are always in need of coaches and managers in a variety of codes. If you have experience in any code, please make contact with us as you maybe the difference between us being able to offer a particular sporting opportunity or not. Even if you have no experience but are willing and able to assist please let us know. Parent Managers do not need any code-specific knowledge and we can help with upskilling anyone interested in coaching through our connections with Sport Waitakere. We also ask that parents
