It is hard to believe that Week 3 is upon us already. We have had an amazing start to 2018 at Bruce McLaren Intermediate School. Our school roll has grown by 15% which is fabulous. No doubt this is down to the hard work that our staff, students and community put into our school.

## COMMUNITY OF LEARNING - EARLY SCHOOL CLOSURE

On Friday 9th March, all schools in the Henderson Community of Learning will be **closed from 1pm**. All teachers of the schools will be in attendance at a COL information and training session. ## EMERGENCY CONTACTS

Have you moved over the holidays or need to update any contact information on your child's enrolment form? It is so important that we have the correct information so that we can contact you, especially in an emergency. ## LATE STUDENTS

Please note that we start our school day at 8:30am. This is when students are in class to commence the day of learning. Should your child be late or absent for any reason, we **MUST** have a written note or phone call to the Admin Team on (09) 836 3175. Any lates or absences without reason are required to be acted upon by the Ministry of Education.

## OFF AT THE GATE

Students, when entering school, are to turn devices off as they enter the school gates and turn them on again as they leave the school gates at the end of the day. Students, when entering school, are to get off bicycles, scooters, skateboards and skates at the school gate for everyone's safety.

## STUDENT VALUABLES

To ensure the safety of any device or valuables brought to school, students are to hand these to their class teacher. 
